INSTRUCTIONS

TAKE A CANVAS. MAKE SOME TINY ART.

Want to participate but can't make the workshop? No problem. Pick up a mini canvas from one of our designated locations and make your artwork on your own time.

A few things to keep in mind:

- Pick up a canvas from one of the designated pickup locations.
- Make it yours. Paint, draw, collage, print, experiment, or combine materials.
- Keep it relatively flat. A little texture or dimension is welcome, but the finished piece has to fit through the Pocket Gallery dispenser.
- Let it dry completely. Artwork must be fully dry before you drop it off so it can be safely loaded into the machine.
- Return your finished artwork to one of the designated drop-off locations by Wednesday, September 30.
